- 1. Start at www.azed.gov
- 2. Using the magnifying glass, type in assessment, don't mark the program area, and click 'apply'
- 3. Click on Welcome to Assessments
- 4. Scroll down to State Assessments
- 5. Click on 'AASA'
- 6. Click on the blue bar with AASA Sample Tests
- 7. Click on the underlined AASA Sample Tests and Tutorials
- 8. Select Arizona
- 9. Click on Mic Check and Sample Tests (You do not need to enter a username or password)
- 10. Select a sample test
- 11. When done with the sample test, close the tab and you'll see the scoring guides
