Principal's report:

-Peter Piper Pizza fundraiser on October 21, brought in \$1,274.00 for Peter Piper so Robison received a check for \$191.21.

-Scouts of America are interested in providing an opportunity to our students and will be at our Winterfest- A Celebration of Literacy and Music night on December 16 to pass handout information and answer questions.

-Early Literacy Grand Monies are approximately \$99,000. We have purchased training for all teachers and support staff for Benchmark Advance curriculum and Scholastic Book Room, and over \$31,000 worth of literacy materials, instructional supplies and reading center furniture. We will continue to purchase training and academic support items for K-3 students.

-Tax Credit Undesignated funds- We are trying to use this money to purchase a shade structure over the kinder courtyard area.

-We are officially a high C and do not have any Federal identifiers for any type of school improvement requirements. Project Momentum support will continue for this year – includes a Principal Partner that is assisting with identifying goals and action steps to continue what we are doing to improve teacher instruction.
